 - Also forfeit 50% of the animals sale check to the Livestock Auction Committee

- Weigh-in and tagging of market animals will be due upon check in
- A copy (no originals) of registration paper and/or chipped goat registration papers (copies only) are required and due at check in.
- All exhibitors, market and exhibition, MUST participate in at least one provided educational event to be Exempt for presenting a notebook

- All hogs will be declared with 840 or NUIS# by June 15th prior to Fair If available, please add ear notches
- No hog will be weighed without proper identification. If numbers do not match hog will be sent home. (Best Practice: Take a Picture of the Tag and Have someone read it while you enter number in FairEntry.)
- Market hog weighs are 225-300 lbs
- Exhibitors must declare what animal will sell at the time of check-in
- Emails will go out June 16th asking if families want 72 hrs or all week

- Market Pictures will be at 3pm-5pm on Sunday at the backdrop, no order. The photographer will be available for 2 hours.

- Thursday @ 9am- Large Animal sale order will be : Goats, Sheep, Hogs, Dairy Feeder, Gallon of Milk, Dairy Market, Beef Feeder, Beef
- Still Exhibits must be signed up in FairEntry then registered for auction by <u>7pm on Saturday</u>, <u>July 30th</u>!
- 2.0 Auction is still available for additional market animals. In order to participate MUST have a slaughter spot before registering. Exhibitor will be responsible for getting animal(s) to slaughter.
 - Exhibitors need to complete a consignment contract and submit to the office BY SATURDAY, JULY 29TH.
 - Digital picture of exhibitor and animal should be submitted by Saturday, August 5th!
- **NO Online Bidding** will take place during the live auctions Wednesday & Thursday. If buyers cannot make it to auction we will have proxy bidders available.

Premiums

- Premiums will be paid by check or in cash. Checks will be ready for pickup at the same time as
 Auction Checks, this information will be communicated once the checks are ready. Exhibitors
 must sign for their premiums if picking up in office, or will be mailed to them.
- Premium checks must be cashed within 60 days of when the check was written. Checks may
 be re-issued after the 60 day period, upon request. Checks requested to be reissued will be
 subject to a \$25 check cancellation fee, to be paid in cash, if the expired check is not returned
 to the office.

General Fair Book Rule

Membership:

- Dues are \$20 and are due October 1st
- Receive discounts on rentals for their membership year.
- Includes a weekly parking pass

Camping:

- Absolutely no overnight parking in the visitor lot. Cars WILL be towed between midnight and 5
 am at the owner's expense. Overnight parking is in designated lots ONLY!
- No Electric available
- Will have 2 (8-stall) Shower Trailers onsite for camping use

Golf Carts:

- All golf carts must be registered with the official permit visible to all times. No limit to clubs
- UTVs allowed, but MUST have utility function
- Forms must be filled out with copies of licenses of all allowed drivers, No one without a driver's license can drive a golf cart!
- Must have insurance on file, must have certain limits! No golf carts/ UTVs will be allowed without insurance.

Late Entry Policy

- 1. Late entries, upon **Superintendent** approval, must be submitted by **July 1st**.
- 2. Exhibitors agree to the following:
 - a. A late entry fee of \$100 for each exhibitor will be assessed.
 - b. Entry fees will be doubled for each class that the exhibitor enters late.
 - c. Late entry exhibitors forfeit their premiums.
 - d. Late entries must be paid in full within 24 hours of submission.
